
Biedenharn Coca-Cola Museum Open all year except New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Mo-Sa, 9:00 am-5:00 pm; Su, 1:30 pm-4:30 pm

DETAILS

Restored 1890 building where Coca-Cola was first bottled anywhere in the world in 1894. Museum contains reproduction bottling works, Coca-Cola memorabilia, 1900 soda fountain and restored 1890 candy store. Listed in the National Register of Historic Places and is a Vicksburg Landmark.

Old Court House Museum (Eva W. Davis Memorial) 1008 Cherry Street Open Mo-Sa, 8:30 am-4:30 pm; Su, 1:30 pm-5:00 pm. Open until 5:00 pm during Daylight Savings Time. Admission charged (\$5 / \$4.50 65+)

DETAILS

Tours are self-guided. Vicksburg's crown jewel both architecturally and historically, this National Landmark towers above the city on hill hallowed by history. It has been a museum since 1948, filled with items reflecting Southern Heritage, from pre-Columbian artifacts to fine portraits, furniture, china, silver, toys, tools, clothing and the largest collection of Civil War memorabilia in the South. Handicapped accessible.
