

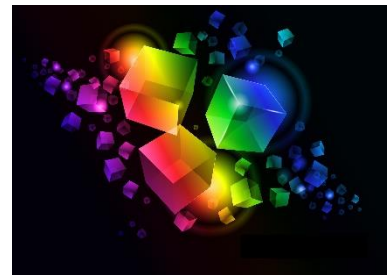

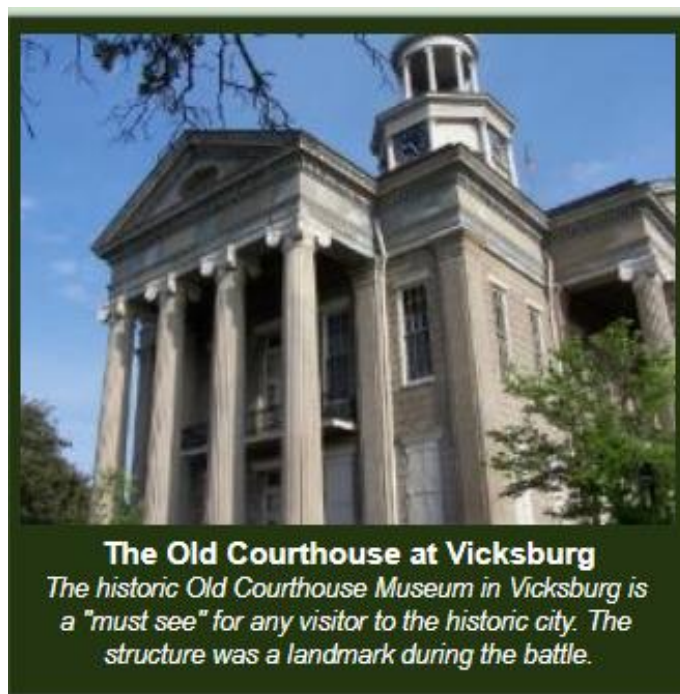
Biedenharn Coca-Cola Museum Open all year except New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Mo-Sa, 9:00 am-5:00 pm; Su, 1:30 pm-4:30 pm

DETAILS

Restored 1890 building where Coca-Cola was first bottled anywhere in the world in 1894. Museum contains reproduction bottling works, Coca-Cola memorabilia, 1900 soda fountain and restored 1890 candy store. Listed in the National Register of Historic Places and is a Vicksburg Landmark.

DETAILS

Tours are self-guided. Vicksburg's crown jewel both architecturally and historically, this National Landmark towers above the city on hill hallowed by history. It has been a museum since 1948, filled with items reflecting Southern Heritage, from pre-Columbian artifacts to fine portraits, furniture, china, silver, toys, tools, clothing and the largest collection of Civil War memorabilia in the South. Handicapped accessible.

The museum houses one of the largest collections in the United States of rare 19th and 20th century French and German bisque dolls, displays of antique Teddy Bears (Steiff and others), Shirley Temple dolls (1934 to present), Madame Alexanders, and more.

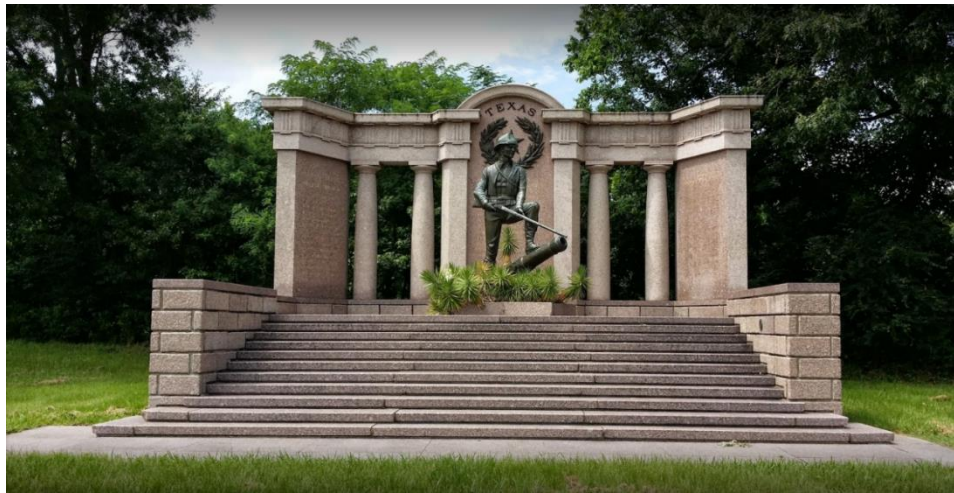
