

## Mississippi Legal Professionals Association 2023 Scholarship Application Requirements

The deadline for receipt of scholarship applications is April 1, 2023. Applications must be submitted on the forms approved by Mississippi Legal Professionals Association.

Eligibility for the scholarship is determined as follows:

- a. Any student who has been accepted in an accredited institution of higher learning.
- b. Any member of Mississippi Legal Professionals Association who has been accepted in an accredited institution of higher learning. This includes online courses which are offered by an accredited institution.

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of scholastic and leadership ability and financial need. The scholarship award may be granted to any qualified applicant with special emphasis on legal education.

The full amount of the grant is to be applied toward college expenses, and payment of the scholarship amount will be made directly to the college of the recipient's choice.

Candidates nominated in prior years, including winners, are eligible to apply again for another award.

The application Form S-1 must be accompanied by the following:

- a. One 1-page letter of recommendation (prepared by non-relative) addressed to the state association setting forth the following:
  - (a) Applicant's activity and leadership record in school and/or community;
  - (b) Description of applicant's personal traits, character, personality, drive;
  - (c) Why applicant wants the scholarship.
  - b. A transcript of the applicant's grades.
- c. A statement (prepared and typed by the applicant) showing schools attended, employment, school activities (honors, clubs, etc.), career goals, and need for financial aid. Such statement should not exceed one page,  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 11", and should not be signed.
